## English

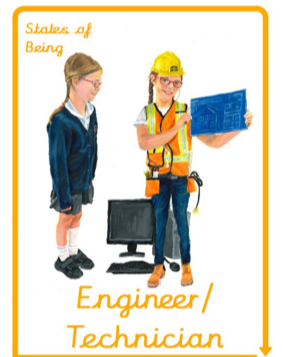
