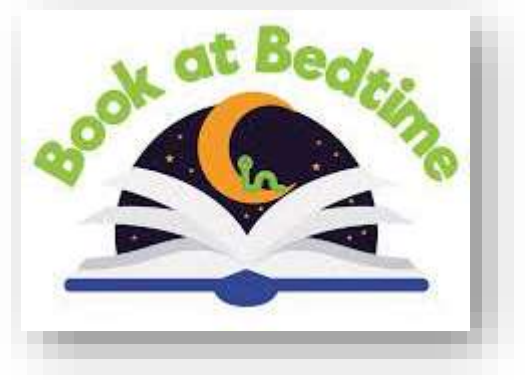

We will be supporting the book at bedtime and also offering drinks and cakes in the hall where you can stay and chat rather than going home during the session. We hope to see many of you and your children there.

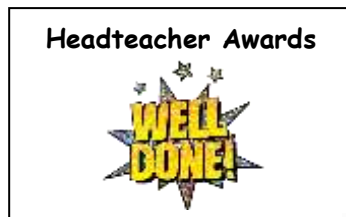


Book at Bedtime - Wednesday 6th March

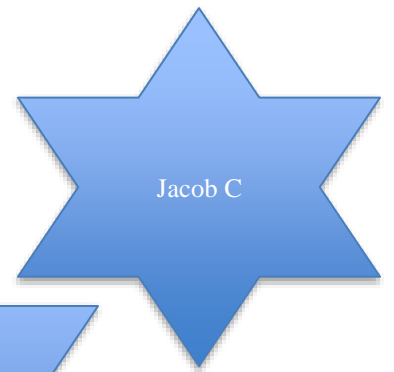
