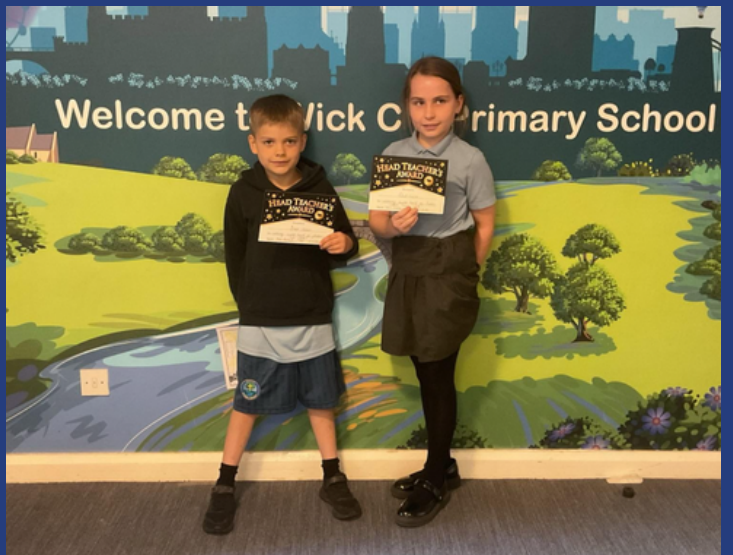
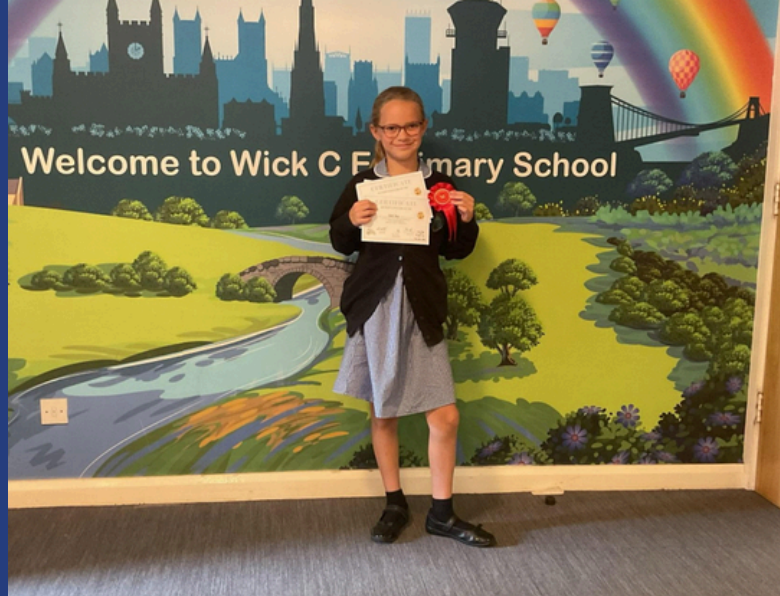

How does Play Therapy Work?

Play Therapy helps children process difficulties through play - their natural language. It is suitable for the vast majority of children and is effective at alleviating a wide range of difficulties (e.g. bereavement, parental separation, low self-esteem, neurodiversity, including ASC, ADHD, OCD etc).

A safe, accepting space, with an empathetic therapist, fosters self-awareness and growth that leads to emotional, social, behavioural, and academic changes.

Sessions, individual or group, are tailored to each child's needs, typically lasting 40 minutes weekly during term time. These may be held in school or in a private location.

A range of toys and creative materials (tools) are available. How the child chooses to use these is generally up to them, as sessions are predominantly child-led and the therapeutic approach is holistic.
